

ACTIVITY INSTRUCTOR

Our Activity Instructor introduce guests to a variety of outdoor activities, from quad biking and fencing to climbing and initiative exercises. You will deliver these sessions safely and ensure our guests have an enjoyable experience.

As a Group Leader you will take care of the pastoral care side of a groups visit, find yourself organising evening entertainment and liaising with visiting teachers and party leaders

The Activity Instructor/Group Leader role combines these two roles enabling you to broaden your own experience and develop numerous transferable skills. You will find yourself delivering both roles but will be able to spend more time in one role depending on where your skills lie.





All of our centres have a gift and tuck shop where guests can buy all manner of our partners related goodies as well as refreshments, souvenirs and confectionery.

Some of our larger centres also have onsite bars which are open in the evening for our partners adult guests and staff – these are also staffed by our Retail Assistants.

At some of our smaller centres this role is combined with that of housekeeping or General Assistant so you will spend your time between the roles.

The gift and tuck shops are open on a daily basis and are where you will predominantly be based. You may have the opportunity, in your spare time, to participate in evening entertainments/activities with our partners guests and build up your skills, competencies and confidence.





GATERING

As a Catering Assistant, you will work in a fun and friendly team who care about delivering the very best dining experience and achieving highs standards of customer service. Working as a Catering Assistant provides a fantastic opportunity to develop your catering skills through learning from catering professionals in a supportive environment.

You'll support the team in a range of tasks from serving, food preparation, pot washing and ensuring dining areas are kept clean and tidy and adhere. Your working week will involve a combination of breakfast, lunch and evening meal shifts but unlike most catering roles you wont be working late into the night with a typical evening shift finishing before 8pm.



HOUSEKEEPING

On a daily basis Housekeeping Assistants will work as part of a large team to prepare and ensure all accommodation and communal areas are kept clean and tidy for our guests.

At some of our smaller centres, this role may also require you to serve guests in the centre shop and conduct stock takes.
